CLUB ETIQUETTE (Revised 2008)

1. Winter Rules. Mark, clean and place ball within 6" of mark (tee to green). No 6" improvement if ball is within one club length of tree trunk. Use of club head to improve ball position is a penalty of one stroke.
2. Summer Rules. All games played in June, July and August will be under Summer Rules regardless of Surrey Golf Course ruling, with the exception that if your ball lies in a divot (any part of the ball touching a divot) on your own fairway, you may take a 6" improvement (Mark, lift – no cleaning, and place). Depending on the course conditions, the Executive has the discretion to change back to Winter Rules.
3. Handicaps. The computer will determine your handicap for each tournament. Your handicap is based on the par and slope rating of white/blue tees. Please post all your scores from other courses played before the next tournament is played.
4. All dues to the Surrey Golf Course and Evergreen Golf Club must be paid in full to be eligible for tournament prizes.
5. All new members must complete 3 rounds of tournament golf and 2 other rounds to qualify for prizes.
6. Late. If you are not at the tee box by the time the first person has teed off, 2-stroke penalty.
7. No shows. Please advise the tournament committee if you are not able to attend the tournament. Any player who does not show without informing the tournament committee will be fined \$ 20.00. For team formatted events, the fine is \$30.00. *Payment of this fine is to be paid before the start of the next tournament to be eligible for prizes.*
8. No gimmies. In tournaments, all putts must be completed.
9. Lost ball. After looking for and not finding your original ball within the allotted time (max 5 min.), the original ball will be in play until you hit your provisional ball.

10. Score cards. Each player will be responsible for the correctness of their score on each hole and on the addition of all totals on a signed and attested scorecard. All score cards must be signed by all players in your group or it is disqualified, NO exceptions.
11. In case of a tie, best net score from the back nine with handicap. If still a tie, hole by hole using net score, counting back from the 18th hole.
12. Tournament rulings and/or disputes are to be presented to the Committee. The Committee shall try to clear up any problems as soon as possible. When a decision by the Committee is accepted by all parties involved and the winners are announced, the tournament is over. If the Committee's decision is still in question, the Committee can withhold the final results of the tournament until all rulings are cleared up. One week to find the correct solution.
13. Club Championship. The Club Championship will be a two round event with only one division. There will be prizes awarded to the low gross winner, second and third low gross score, low net winner and second and third low net score
14. Match Play Qualifying will be held May 4, 2008 and May 11, 2008. Your May 4th round will be the official qualifying score if you play both rounds. The first match must be completed in June, the second round in July, the semi-finals in August and the Match Play final in September. In Match Play the player shall inform the opponent of the holes at which strokes are given or taken.
